

# The Weekly Fee

Lifestyle Communities charge a weekly fee to cover the costs of running and maintaining the community. If you are on the Age Pension or other eligible Government payment you may be able to recoup part of these costs through the Federal Government Rent Assistance program.

## How much is the weekly fee?



SINGLES	WEEKLY FEE
Single person on the Age Pension or other eligible Government payment	\$119.22 ( $\$192.12$ less $\$72.90$ Rent Assistance rebate*)
Single self-funded retiree & those still working full time	\$192.12



COUPLES	WEEKLY FEE
Couple on the Age Pension or other eligible Government payment	\$154.66 ( $\$221.96$ less $\$68.70$ Rent Assistance rebate*)
Couple self-funded retirees & those still working full time	\$221.96

## Payable dates and increases

Under the agreement with Lifestyle Communities, the weekly site fee is payable by direct debit each fortnight. The site fee is reviewed annually and increases are capped at CPI or 3.5%, whichever is greater.

Access to facilities and amenities within the community and clubhouse all year round



Maintenance of the clubhouse facilities, and landscaping of your front yard and common areas



Internet and WiFi access in the clubhouse
